Son of G.H. and Elizabeth Dallow, of Tower Hill, Llangarren, Ross. Born at Tetire, Ross.



Harry Dallow was born at Bryce Lodge, Dymock, the son of George Henry and Elizabeth Dallow. His mother died in childbirth in 1893. His father married again and in 1901 the family were living in Llangarren, Ross and George was a cattle stockman on a farm. In 1911 most of his family were living at Three Ashes near Ross. Harry does not appear on the 1911 census, but his younger sister was living with their grandparents Joseph and Emily Brook at The Farm, Much Marcle. Harry enlisted in Hereford and joined the Herefordshire Regiment. On enlisting Harry stated that he lived in Peterstow, Ross. Harry died in Bedford in June 1916 and is buried in Yatton churchyard.
