Percy Allen Haines was born in Much Marcle in 1900. He was one of the eight children of Thomas and Mary Haines. In 1901 Thomas was recorded as an agricultural labourer and the family were living in Fiddler's Bank Cottage, Yatton. By 1911 the family were living in Laburnam Cottage, Yatton and Thomas was a woodman on an estate. Percy at 11 was still at school. He enlisted and became an air mechanic and died in Brentford in September 1918 and is buried in a war grave in Yatton churchyard
