Albert Leonard Hope was born in Brooms Green in October 1891, the son of John and Lucy Hope. He was baptised in Dymock on 6th December 1891. By 1901 the family were living at Wiggons Ash Much Marcle and John was a carter on a farm. At the time of the 1911 the census both Leonard and his father were farm labourers and the family were in Gamage Cottage Much Marcle. Leonard enlisted in Ledbury and was in the 1st Reserve Battalion of the Herefordshire regiment. He died at Oswestry in February 1917 and is buried in a war grave in Much Marcle churchyard.
