Joseph Lewis Symonds was born in Much Marcle in 1894. He was one of the six children of Edward and Celia Symonds. Edward was a bricklayer and the family lived in Dingle Cottage, Old Ross Rd, Much Marcle. In the 1911 census Lewis at 10 was still at school. Lewis enlisted in Hereford and joined the South Wales Borderers. Lewis died in St Asaph in 1918 and is buried in a war grave in Much Marcle. His brother Harold died in June 1917 and is buried in Gaza War Cemetery.
