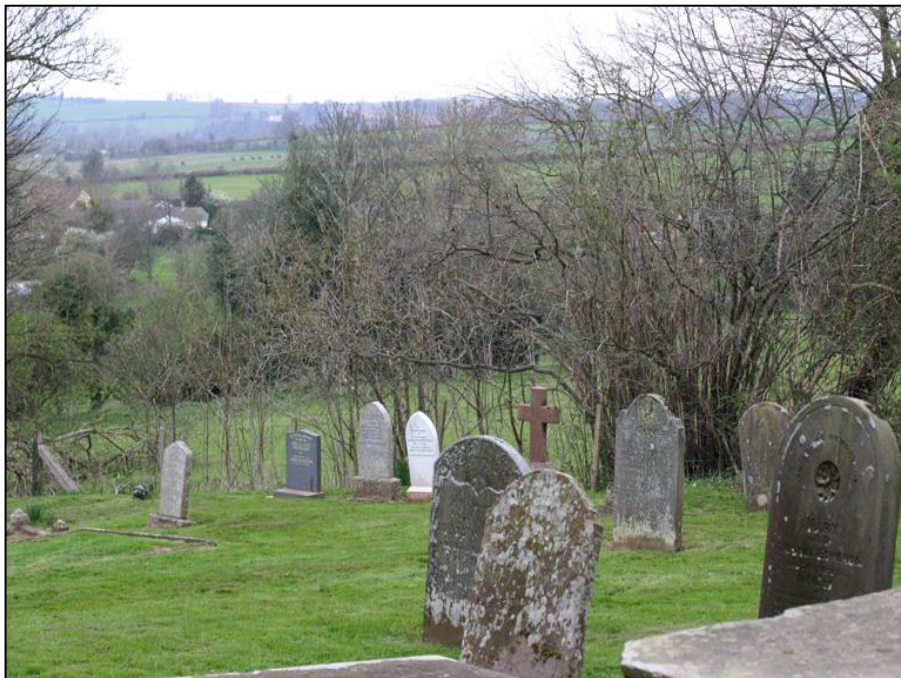

Charles Terry was born in Fawley near Brockhampton in 1881. He was one of the nine children of Henry and Ann Terry. Henry was a labourer and road contractor. In addition Henry and Ann became publicans at the Yew Tree public house, Fawley. Charles was first a general labourer and by the time of the 1911 census he was a domestic gardener in Burton Bucknell Shropshire. He enlisted in Hereford into the King's Liverpool Regiment. He died at the Oswestry depot in March 1917 and is buried in the churchyard at King's Cople.
